SHIFTNC cites 314 pregnancies in 2014. What they don't tell is that of that number, 273 pregnancies were among 18 & 19 year olds, and of that number, over 170 were married.

Reducing pregnancies among the married citizens of our County is none of SHIFT's business.

Only 41 pregnancies were among school age Teens, age 15-17. Of this number, 10 were married leaving only 31 unmarried 15-17 year olds getting pregnant While we would all like to see that number reduced, SHIFT NC's program is not the way to do it. After 5 years of SHIFT's program in Gaston County, their age 15-17 number of pregnancies was 39% higher than Onslow County's for that same year.

Pregnancy numbers have been verified through the NC Vital Statistics.
